Prof. Kawashima: In the 1980s, I was a graduate student at Tohoku University. I was studying brain science, but I had a big problem. I needed a lot of money for 5 my research. One day I hit upon an idea: "While we are playing an exciting video game, we use our eyes, ears, hands, and mind so much. Our brain must work very actively. On the other hand, how does it work while we are doing simple calculations? I will conduct 10 experiments to compare these two mental activities. If I get the results I expect, I can get money for my research from a video game company."

I did some experiments. Fortunately or unfortunately,
I got the opposite results. The results are shown in 15
Figures 1 and 2.
